

Thiele Releases Gas Price Survey For March 30, 2013

Winter Prices Increase; South Fork Prices Are 12 Cents above the Long Island Average

New York State Assemblyman Fred W. Thiele, Jr. (I, D, WF-Sag Harbor) today announced his most recent survey of gasoline prices. In Thiele's most recent gasoline survey for the South Fork taken on March 30, 2013, South Fork prices increased by 8 cents since February 8, 2013. Long Island and New York State prices have decreased by 2 cents and a penny, respectively, during the same period. South Fork prices are now 15 cents above the State average and 12 cents above the Long Island average. South Fork gas prices have been higher than the Long Island average in 15 of the 25 surveys since Memorial Day 2011.

The Automobile Association of America (AAA) provides for a regional survey on New York State gasoline prices. However, there is no survey solely for the South Fork. Thiele's survey also includes prices in western Southampton along Montauk Highway. There may be prices that are higher or lower in the region away from Montauk Highway, but the survey reflects the price posted at most stations on our region's main arterials.

Thiele stated, "The average price for East Hampton and Southampton along Montauk Highway excluding Amagansett and Montauk is now \$4.05. The average price for Amagansett is \$4.39 and the average price for Montauk is \$4.46. A gallon of gas on the North Fork is now about \$3.85. The Long Island average is \$3.93 and the State average is \$3.90."

Thiele has re-introduced his legislation to strengthen New York's law on zone pricing of gasoline as recommended by the State Attorney General. The Assembly overwhelmingly passed Thiele's bill in 2012, but the measure did not pass in the State Senate. Senator Ken LaValle is the new sponsor in the State Senate for 2013.
