ASSEMBLYMAN AL GRAF AND THE MINORITY CONFERENCE HAVE PROPOSED THE APPLE PLAN TO REFORM COMMON CORE

Evaluate State Assessments and Curriculum: Put the brakes on failed curriculum that is hurting our children and develop curriculum that takes into consideration our children's individual abilities to learn, in order to receive the best educational experience possible.

Funding Equity: Eliminate the GEA (Gap Elimination Adjustment) allowing our schools to get the resources they need while easing the strain on taxpayers.

Restrict Use of Student Data: Limit the disclosure of student information to private corporations. Require written parental consent or written consent of eligible students (18 years old) before such information can be disclosed.

21st Century Pathways: Create alternate pathways to a high school diploma including a Career and Technical Education pathway. Increase state funding for BOCES.

Provide Equity for Special-Needs Students: Require that the State Education Department comply with Federal law. A student's IEP must be followed and the IEP Team's recommendations may not be disregarded.
