This year's state budget:


- **ensures** that eligible seniors on EPIC will once again pay no more than \$20 for their prescription drug co-pay

Prescription cost (after Medicare)	EPIC Co-payment
Under \$15.00	\$3
\$15.01 to \$35.00	\$7
\$35.01 to \$55.00	\$15
Over \$55.01	\$20
