Legislative Victories

There were a number of initiatives this year that will have a lasting impact on local families, including:

- **Voting against 76 tax increases, that would have cost New Yorkers \$1.7 billion;**
- **Restoring \$90 million in funding to help care for the developmentally disabled;**
- **Increasing library aid by \$4 million; and**
- **Supporting a jobs package that will grow existing businesses and encourage entrepreneurs to open new businesses.**

Budget Report

I also worked hard to ensure that crucial commitments were upheld to economic development, families and local government by:

- **Extending the lowest middle-class income tax rate in 58 years;**
- **Restoring funding for EPIC co-payment assistance for seniors;**
- **Providing Long Island school districts with approximately \$2.5 billion in aid; and**
- **Dedicating over \$800 million in funding for upkeep of local roads over the next two years.**
