# 2016 LEGISLATIVE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

While there are still plenty of issues to address to create a brighter future for Long Island families, bills we passed during the last six months put us on a great path to do just that.

**Record Education Funding** – Successfully restored all education funding cuts, allowing our schools to retain talented educators and valuable programs. (A.9003D and A.9006C)

**Ethics Reforms** – Passed an ethics measure that will help hold officials accountable and clean up Albany by stripping pensions from corrupt politicians. (A.10739-A)

**Heroin & Opioids** – Passed a collection of bills that will help Long Island families and communities combat the heroin epidemic. (A.10725, A.10726, A.10727)

**Commitment to Higher Education** – Provided an additional \$50 million in capital funding to the SUNY & CUNY school systems. (A.10741)
