## PROTECTING THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF OUR KIDS

In response to recent tests showing many Suffolk County schools had unsafe levels of lead in their drinking water, Assemblywoman Jean-Pierre fought for legislation providing school districts with the funding they need to regularly test their water for lead to protect the health and safety of our children.

## FIGHTING THE HEROIN AND OPIOID EPIDEMIC

- ✓ educate patients and doctors about the risks of opioid painkillers
- ✓ expand access to coverage and treatment
- ✓ allow social workers and certain other licensed professionals to administer Narcan
