FAST FACTS

- Over the past decade, 111 bills containing unfunded mandates passed the Assembly for a projected cost to municipalities of almost \$77 billion.
- According to the independent Tax Foundation, New York now ranks 49th in the nation for business climate because of taxes and mandates.
- In Nassau County, the largest unfunded mandate is Medicaid which cost county taxpayers \$230.4 million in the 2011-12 fiscal year.

Now ED is working to provide more relief to New York families and businesses:

- Capped local Medicaid costs this year and work to implement a full state takeover of the program over the next few years.
- Saved the state, local governments and homeowners \$80 billion over the next 30 years by creating a new pension tier.
- Place a moratorium on any new unfunded state mandates.
