During my first year-and-a-half in the Assembly, I have focused on reinvigorating New York's economy by creating jobs on Long Island and spurring economic development across the Empire State.

Partnering with Governor Andrew Cuomo and Senator Dean Skelos, I've successfully passed measures that will continue to create and retain jobs, making Long Island an even better place to live, work and raise a family. My achievements include:

- **Cutting** the State Budget and reducing government spending two years in a row;
- **Capping** local property tax growth by two percent;
- **Providing** a Middle Class Tax Cut to our working families and seniors;
- **Eliminating** 80 percent of the job-killing MTA Payroll Tax;
- **Reducing** the Corporate Franchise Tax by up to 50 percent; and
- **Increasing** school aid funding to all school districts for 2012-13 to keep property taxes down and save jobs.

And this important work needs to continue. It's my top priority to fight for our working families and seniors by providing relief from New York's crushing taxes while stimulating the economy and putting more New Yorkers back to work.

And it's working... from March 2011 to March 2012, 155,000 private sector jobs were created in New York State. In fact, our 2012 private sector job count is at an all time high at 7.3 million. In March of 2012, almost 18 percent of new jobs in the U.S. were created in New York.

Our community's future depends on creating an environment that keeps businesses and jobs here in New York State. We have certainly come a long way in a short time. With your help, I know we can accomplish even more.

## How Assemblyman Brian Curran is creating and retaining jobs in New York:

- Two percent local property tax cap;
- Passed two consecutive on-time State Budgets with no new taxes or fees;
- \$101.6 million in economic development projects for Long Island;
- \$74 million to fix the region's state parks and roadways; \$1.6 billion to repair roadways, bridges and infrastructure; and
- Organized a successful Jobs Fair at Molloy College, bringing 80+ hiring organizations and businesses to job-seekers. Many new employees were hired on the spot.
