


## Assemblyman Brian Curran is fighting for Baldwin and your community.

Over the last four years, we have:

- Helped Baldwin residents by hosting numerous Superstorm Sandy Town Hall meetings and financial aid workshops. Partnered with National Guard to distribute food and supplies at Meadow School to everyone in need;
- Fought for and achieved record levels of school aid – an increase of \$1,524,463 for public schools – and significantly increased state aid to non-public schools like St. Christopher’s and private schools each year in Baldwin;
- Secured \$32,933 in library aid for the Baldwin Public Library;
- Held several clean-ups at Silver Lake, Millburn and Millburn Pond Park;
- Hosted the first community festival called Baldwin Halloweenfest with Nassau County Executive Ed Mangano;
- Hosted the Winners Inc. motivational program with Molloy College for Baldwin High School Students featuring former Giants linebacker Keith Davis, who, with another guest NFL colleague, speaks at events across New York State. During the program, these and other former professional football players spread a message of hope, hard work, achievement and tenacity;
- Hosted community outreach programs such as car seat safety checks for parents, breast cancer mammogram screenings for Baldwin residents, and informational seminars on cyberbullying for Baldwin families;
- Honored veterans and women of distinction from the Baldwin community;
- Fought against the closure of First Precinct in Baldwin;




Helped many neighbors and families get answers to questions on Sandy recovery, insurance questions and FEMA-related concerns at my mobile office hours in Baldwin.


