ASSEMBLYMAN BRIAN CURRAN DELIVERS FOR ROCKVILLE CENTRE:

- Since 2011, school aid has INCREASED for Rockville Centre Union Free School by 40%, for a total of \$10,005,577;
- Secured an increase of over \$12.6 million in funding for our state libraries this year and \$68,038,000, a 66% increase, for non-public (private) schools, like St. Agnes School, since 2011; and
- Secured \$596,178.45 in road repair funds and \$74,764.28 in winter recovery funds for the Village of Rockville Centre since 2014.
