

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATIVE REPORT: HEWLETT

ASSEMBLYMAN BRIAN CURRAN'S HEWLETT LEGISLATION:

- Since 2011, school aid has INCREASED for Hewlett Woodmere School District by 38%, for a total of \$9,146,393;
- Since 2011, secured an increase of over \$12.6 million in funding for our state libraries and \$68,038,000, or a 66% increase, for non-public (private) Catholic, and Yeshiva schools; and
- Secured \$5,436,053.28 in road repair funds and \$726,504.05 in winter recovery funds for the Town of Hempstead, including Hewlett, since 2014.

SOME OF OUR HEWLETT COMMUNITY OUTREACH:

- Held a Town Hall Meeting at the Hewlett Public Library on the 2015 Executive Budget;
- Participated in a bi-partisan forum at Temple Hillel with Congressman Lee Zeldin, where over 300 people from the area participated, highlighting the issues that Jewish voters face today;
- Working closely with Senior Councilman Anthony J. Santino, Assemblyman Curran sponsored legislation that makes the display of a swastika a hate crime;
- Honored Hewlett's 2015 Woman of Distinction: Cheryl May.
- Honored local veteran for this year's Veterans' Hall of Honor: from Five Towns Kempton Hicks; and
- In the 2014 and 2015 legislative sessions, Assemblyman Brian Curran was a main and/or co-sponsor on 48 bills that passed the New York State Assembly.
