

# NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATIVE REPORT: VALLEY STREAM

## ASSEMBLYMAN BRIAN CURRAN'S VALLEY STREAM LEGISLATION:

- Since 2011, school aid has INCREASED for Valley Stream #24 School District by 22%, for a total of \$5,687,432;
- Since 2011, school aid has INCREASED for Valley Stream #13 School District by 21%, for a total of \$10,297,025;
- Since 2011, secured an increase of over \$12.6 million in funding for our state libraries and \$68,038,000, or a 66% increase, for non-public (private); and
- Secured \$861,865.09 in road repair funds and \$109,292.18 in winter recovery funds for the Village of Valley Stream since 2014.

## SOME OF OUR VALLEY STREAM COMMUNITY OUTREACH:

- Partnered with the Integrated Medical Foundation and Shiel Medical Laboratory to host a free prostate cancer screening for Valley Stream families at Arthur J. Hendrickson Park Community Center;
- Hosted a fun, family-friendly Kids Pop Art Activity Class with Artist and Author Michael Albert, Senior Councilman Anthony J. Santino, and Mayor Ed Fare;
- Honored Valley Stream's 2015 Woman of Distinction: Sharon Daly for her support for the Valley Stream Green Hornet's Youth Football Organization;
- Honored local veteran for this year's Veterans' Hall of Honor: Martin T. Kielawa; and
- In the 2014 and 2015 legislative sessions, Assemblyman Brian Curran was a main and/or co-sponsor on 48 bills that passed the New York State Assembly.
