

# NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATIVE REPORT: WEST HEMPSTEAD

## ASSEMBLYMAN BRIAN CURRAN'S WEST HEMPSTEAD LEGISLATION:

- Since 2011, school aid has INCREASED for West Hempstead Union Free School District by 22%, for a total of \$9,304,860;
- Since 2011, secured an increase of over \$12.6 million in funding for our state libraries and \$68,038,000, or a 66% increase, for non-public (private) and Yeshivas schools; and
- Secured \$5,436,053.28 in road repair funds and \$726,504.05 in winter recovery funds for the Town of Hempstead, including West Hempstead, since 2014.

## SOME OF OUR WEST HEMPSTEAD COMMUNITY OUTREACH:

- Held a Town Hall Meeting about the 2015 Executive Budget;
- Hosted a free car seat safety check for parents and grandparents in the area;
- Hosted a Substance Abuse Awareness and Overdose Prevention Training with Nassau County Executive Ed Mangano, the West Hempstead Parent, Teacher, Student Association (PTSA) and the Nassau County Police Department;
- Honored West Hempstead's 2015 Woman of Distinction Lauren Lee Bristol for her efforts as the West Hempstead PTSA board as Vice President of Programming and for founding the West Hempstead Chiefs TOPSoccer program for children with disabilities;
- Honored a local veteran for this year's Veterans' Hall of Honor: John Shaud; and
- In the 2014 and 2015 legislative sessions, Assemblyman Brian Curran was a main and/or co-sponsor on 48 bills that passed the New York State Assembly.
