Town Hall Meeting on the State Budget

Dear Friends,

Governor Cuomo's Education Budget provides a meager ½ of 1 percent increase in State Aid for New York City schools, but provides more if the Legislature permits tens of thousands of students to divert from public schools to charter schools and allows an increase in the use of test scores to fire teachers and principals.

Governor Cuomo's the MTA budget provides a .2 of 1 percent increase in operating aid for the MTA. At the same time, he has vetoed the MTA Capital budget, leaving a \$14 billion shortfall in scheduled replacement of trains, buses, track, signals and other investments.
