Assemblymember Harris fought for a state budget that helps our children succeed

- ✓ \$525 million more in education aid for NYC schools, totaling \$9.7 billion – an increase of 5.7 percent
- ✓ \$23.8 million for college opportunity programs – an increase of 20 percent – to give more students the chance to earn a college degree
- ✓ a tuition freeze at CUNY and SUNY colleges for the upcoming year and a \$30 million increase in funding to protect the vital programs they offer
