

## ***Traffic Light Approved for 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 66<sup>th</sup> Street***



Some time ago, area residents requested that a traffic signal be put at the intersection of 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 66<sup>th</sup> Street because of the unsafe environment at this corner.

On behalf of the community and because of the dangerous conditions at this location, I contacted the Department of Transportation (DOT) and urged them to take the necessary steps for installing a traffic signal to help make this intersection safer for our community.

As a result of our efforts, the Traffic Department conducted a study and determined that a traffic signal is warranted at this location. The installation of a traffic signal at this intersection is long overdue. This signal will help the flow of traffic and make the street safer for pedestrians and automobiles. DOT believes that this light will be installed by February 28, 2013. A copy of the letter I received from DOT is on the other side of this note.

I will continue to do all I can to see that traffic signals at dangerous locations be put up to increase our safety.
