





That's why he encourages recent grads to take advantage of the Get On Your Feet Loan Forgiveness Program

Created as part of the 2015-16 state budget, this new program offers up to two years of federal student loan debt relief to help recent grads who are working to build a financial foundation.

Graduates who meet the following conditions may be eligible for the program:*

- ✓ Graduated from both high school and college in New York State
- ✓ Graduated with an undergraduate degree in or after the 2014-15 academic year
- ✓ Enrolled in a federal income-based or pay-as-you-earn repayment program
- ✓ Have an adjusted gross income of less than \$50,000

**Additional criteria also apply*
