GIVING US PAID LEAVE TO CARE FOR OUR FAMILIES

This year Assemblywoman Maritza Davila and the New York State Assembly confirmed their commitment to caring for working families by mandating paid leave for workers who need time off to care for sick loved ones or welcome a new family member.

Starting in 2018 employees will be eligible for 12 weeks of paid family leave when caring for an infant, a family member with a serious health condition or to relieve family pressures when someone is called to active military service.

In her two terms in office, Assemblywoman Maritza Davila has set a new trend at the state level in targeting capital dollars to support and improve the distressed infrastructure of NYCHA buildings.

2014: \$500,000 to improve boilers at **Hope Gardens**

\$125,000 to upgrade Senior Centers at **Hope Gardens** and **Borinquen Plaza**

2015: \$2.5 million to upgrade the heating systems, elevators, TA room and Community Center at **Bushwick Houses**

\$250,000 to improve the grounds of **Borinquen Plaza**

2016: Stay tuned for this year's allocations for **Williamsburg Houses, Hylan Houses** and **Borinquen Plaza**.

Assemblywoman Maritza Davila is a strong ally for the public schools in her district. Whether supporting our teachers or ensuring education for our children, Assemblywoman Davila is a voice you can count on in Albany.

As our public schools struggle to find the funds for programming and materials, Assemblywoman Davila made a commitment to fund capital needs in a big way in 2016 by allocating:

\$500,000 to upgrade the auditorium at **PS 376**

\$250,000 to upgrade the gymnasium at **IS 162**

\$125,000 to renovate the floors throughout at **PS 145**

\$125,000 to improve programming space in **Progress High School**

We all know that rent is high and getting higher, that is why Assemblywoman Davila is a staunch advocate for preserving and building housing that is truly affordable to the residents that have made Williamsburg and Bushwick vibrant through their decades of leadership.

Here are a few things you should know:

- The rent increases for rent-stabilized leases beginning October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017 are: 0% for a one-year lease and 2% for a two-year lease

- You can access and apply for affordable housing lotteries online at www.nyc.gov/housingconnect
- **TENANTS HAVE RIGHTS!** If your landlord is harassing you, has said you have to leave, refuses to make repairs, or has served you with court papers don't panic, seek help immediately.
