The state budget includes \$170 million to fight the heroin epidemic, including:

- ✓ Funding for **treatment and recovery** services
- ✓ \$25 million for **heroin and opiate treatment and prevention** services
- ✓ \$2 million to continue **prevention and education programs** in New York City
- ✓ \$1 million for **safe drug disposal** programs
