

Dear Neighbor,

Recently, you may have heard that the "Plastic Bag Tax" bill passed by the New York City Council in 2016 has been stopped. I strongly feel that a tax charging at least five cents on plastic and paper bags would unfairly burden New York City taxpayers and would not be a reasonable solution to this longstanding problem. In response, along with Senator Simcha Felder, I led the way in passing my bill, A.4883, which puts a moratorium on the city law effectively pausing the tax for a year and allowing us to come up with alternative measures to curb the use of plastic bags.

However, I know full well of the environmental impact that these disposable bags can have on our streets, in our parks, and in our waterways. That is why I'm asking for your help.

I want to make certain that each and every opinion and suggestion of my constituents is taken into consideration before seeking a further cost-effective and environmentally-friendly solution to this important issue. Your participation will help the state legislature formulate a real plan to address the impact plastic bags have on our environment. I ask that you please take a few moments to answer the enclosed questionnaire.
