# Assemblywoman Malliotakis: Getting New York back into shape.

## **REBUILDING THE MIDDLE CLASS:**

New York lost the highest percentage of population in the nation during the last decade (The Empire Center) by pricing out its young people. Nicole voted to reduce middle-class tax rates to their lowest point in 58 years (A.40002). We must continue to drive down taxes for families and job creators so New Yorkers can obtain the American Dream.

## **STRENGTHENING JOB CREATION:**

New York's business tax climate was ranked second worst out of all 50 states in 2009 (The Tax Foundation). To help re-open New York for business, Nicole voted to repeal the MTA Payroll Tax for small businesses and schools (A.40002). If we're going to finish the job, we can continue moving forward by getting rid of the most expensive and unnecessary mandates found in New York's 49,000 pages of job-killing regulations.

## **TRIMMING TAXES AND SPENDING:**

In 2009, the state budget increased spending by a state record \$10 billion, increasing taxes and fees by \$4.4 billion. Since taking office in 2010, Nicole has voted to close two combined budget deficits of \$13.5 billion by reducing spending, without any new or increased taxes or fees (A.4011-C of 2011, A.9059-D of 2012). Let's leave the bad-old-days of taxing and spending behind.
