BROOKLYN AND JOBS

- >> Assemblywoman Nicole Malliotakis voted to fund grants for locally-targeted job creation and helped repeal the MTA Payroll Tax for small businesses and schools.
- >> Now, state government must address the burdensome regulations, utility fees and other cost drivers that hurt job creators.

BROOKLYN AND COST RELIEF

- >> Assemblywoman Nicole Malliotakis used her vote to reduce middle-class tax rates to their lowest point in 58 years and supported the sunset of the sales tax on clothing items under \$110. This cost relief was made possible by closing two combined budget deficits of \$13.5 billion by reducing spending instead of raising taxes.
- >> While we finally received a discount program from the Port Authority, we must continue to make transportation more affordable for Brooklynites.

BROOKLYN AND TRANSPORTATION

- >> Assemblywoman Nicole Malliotakis led the fight to restore bus service in our community and bring fiscal sanity to the MTA.
- >> We must continue to find ways to reduce non-transportation expenses and identify alternative sources of revenue for the agency, to relieve its reliance on increased tolls and fares.

BROOKLYN AND SAFETY

- >> Assemblywoman Nicole Malliotakis worked to create the prescription drug tracking program to keep dangerous pills off our streets and expand the DNA database to keep criminals behind bars.
- >> If we're going to protect our families and get tough on crime, we need to strengthen penalties against drunk drivers by taking away their ability to operate a vehicle.
