## The B37 bus is back! Here's some other good news that's happened in our community recently:

- ◆ The Assembly passed legislation to control the cost of living for senior citizens by altering the Senior Citizen Rent Increase Exemption (SCRIE) program. The bill would help participants renew their benefits and enroll new eligible residents, assisting those with physical, language or technological difficulties.
- ◆ The Assembly approved the Farm to Seniors program to promote the purchase of healthy New York farm products by senior centers and other aging institutions.
- ◆ Measures were passed to help spot elder abuse and increase awareness of resources available to seniors who have been harmed.
- ◆ A bill passed by the Assembly would ensure that the financial institutions our seniors rely on the most are held to the highest standards of accountability and that no misdeed can slip through the cracks by creating requirements for reporting suspected exploitation of a senior citizen.
