Assemblywoman Malliotakis and the state Legislature passed sweeping legislation to combat the prescription drug abuse and heroin epidemic plaguing our communities.

The comprehensive package addresses three major components of the epidemic by:

- Improving treatment options for those who fall into addiction
- Creating education programs to raise awareness of the severity of heroin usage and addiction
- Establishing harsher penalties for those who unlawfully sell controlled substances

Assemblywoman Malliotakis is also fighting to increase penalties and lengthen sentences for drug dealers.

Assemblywoman Malliotakis and District Attorney Dan Donovan implemented a prescription drug take-back program to provide a safe place for people to drop off unwanted or unused prescriptions.
