PAYING FOR COLLEGE AND GRADUATE SCHOOL

-  **Increased funding for community college students** and the Tuition Assistance Program (TAP);
-  **Fighting to expand the income eligibility threshold for tuition assistance** so more middle-class students can qualify; and
-  **Introduced legislation to restore TAP** for graduate students eliminated in 2010 so more students can afford an advanced degree.

CREATING JOBS

-  **Worked to eliminate mandates on employers** by repealing unnecessary reporting requirements;
-  **Alleviated burdens** to improve tax climate and attract businesses by eliminating manufacturing tax and MTA payroll tax and reducing the corporate income tax and hidden energy tax in utility bills; and
-  **Supported commerce** with creation of first-ever Verrazano and Port Authority commercial bridge toll plans.
