Reform Finally Makes Its Way To Albany:

The Assembly acted this year and adopted three reforms I fought for:

- Stripping taxpayer-funded pensions from public officials who betray the public trust and are convicted of crimes related to their position
- Making all committee votes accessible to the public on the Assembly website
- Live broadcasting of all committee meetings online to bring transparency to the legislative process.

Help & Hope for New York Families

This year we took significant steps forward in addressing the heroin epidemic that has plagued our state. The comprehensive legislation signed into law aims to:

- Eliminate insurance barriers to addiction treatment
- Add treatment services and program slots for substance abuse statewide
- Reduce the supply of opioid medication that can be initially prescribed
- Continuing education for doctors and the public about addiction and pain management.

Here Are Some Other Measures Adopted This Year:

- Middle-class tax cut that increases over eight years
- Increased funding for MTA bus and transit services
- Veterans will be eligible to receive pension service credit regardless of when or where they served
- Holding banks accountable for maintenance of foreclosed property
- Hospitals and vital community health services will receive more funding
- Legalized Mixed Martial Arts which will boost the economy
- Approved Daily Fantasy Sports which will generate an estimated \$28 million in revenue for education
- Expanded access to and availability of breast cancer screenings for early detection
