A GOVERNMENT FOR THE PEOPLE



This session, my colleagues and I passed a constitutional amendment that would strip corrupt public officials of their taxpayer-funded pensions. The Assembly also adopted two of my proposals that will increase transparency, including broadcasting committee meetings and requiring the votes within these committees to be made available to the public. We must continue to push for both ethics and rules reforms critical to bringing transparency and accountability to Albany.

We must enact rules changes that limit the Speaker's ability to

- Secretly dole out grants without legislative approval;
- Unilaterally maintain a slush fund of taxpayer money to spend;
- Unilaterally stop legislation from coming to the floor despite overwhelming bi-partisan support; and
- Unilaterally strip members of leadership positions, stipends or staff allocation if they simply disagree with him or her.

Also, changing the way the Assembly operates will assist in rooting out corruption. Some of these changes include

- Implementing eight-year term limits for legislative leaders and committee chairs;
- Requiring every transfer of money in the state budget to be approved by the attorney general so no conflict of interest exists; and
- Prohibiting any distribution of money to organizations that employ or compensate the governor, a legislator or family member
