

A new law* went into effect Jan. 1 that:



Eliminates annual deductibles, co-payments and co-insurance payments for mammograms, breast ultrasounds and MRIs




Requires clinics and hospitals to hold extended screening hours to accommodate people who work full time



Provides four hours of paid leave for NYC public employees to get screenings
