In Greenburgh, Tarrytown, Irvington, Dobbs Ferry, Hastings, Elmsford, Ardsley and Sleepy Hollow, we don't have our own sales tax or hotel tax. We have high property taxes!

That's not fair.

- Abinanti's bill (A.992) would let us impose a small 3% hotel room tax.
- Greenburgh alone could raise \$1 million.
- Out-of-towners who stay in our hotels would contribute to the cost of the public services they use.
