

Cutting Taxes for Hardworking Families

Assemblyman Buchwald is getting Westchester families the tax relief they need. For the next two years, many homeowners will receive two-year property tax rebate checks, and Buchwald helped reduce an energy tax for residents and businesses. Additionally, this year's state budget raises the estate tax threshold from \$1 million to \$5.25 million over four years, ensuring that homes and small businesses go to loved ones, not the tax collector.

Fighting to Keep Tesla Facilities Open in New York

Assemblyman Buchwald successfully led the charge against a bill that would have forced Tesla, an electric vehicle company in our community, to close its facilities (A.7844). Because of his efforts to change the bill, Tesla Motors can continue innovating environmentally friendly cars, offering more choices for consumers and retaining quality jobs at three facilities in Westchester.

Attracting Young Professionals to Westchester

Our community's future depends on the success of our young adults and small businesses. He also helped secure funding for programs, like New York Youth Works, to connect businesses to the young adult workforce.

Reducing Costs for Local Businesses

Securing Funding for Local Infrastructure
