Assemblyman David Buchwald *is leading efforts to root out public corruption*



- ◆ Sponsored legislation to strip taxpayer-funded pensions from government officers convicted of corruption (A.7704)
- ◆ Voted against a backdoor effort to raise legislators' salaries without a cap on outside income (A.6721-A/S.4610-A)
- ◆ Spoke out and urged leadership resignations in light of recent corruption scandals
- ◆ Helped create the Assembly Reform Caucus to encourage greater openness and participation within state government
- ◆ Sponsored and passed legislation to strengthen the Freedom of Information Law (FOIL) and increase transparency in government (A.114)

Assemblyman Buchwald will keep pushing to strip taxpayer-funded pensions from corrupt government officials, because officials who betray the public trust shouldn't retire on the taxpayers' dime.
