

13 cars carrying ethanol ignited, causing one death.


**Lac-Mégantic, QC
July 2013**
A train explodes, killing 47 and spilling crude.

**Lynchburg, VA
April 2014**
Over a dozen tank cars derail, spilling oil in the James River.

**Aliceville, AL
November 2013**
26 cars derail, releasing Bakken crude.
