WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW... ABOUT THE NY SAFE ACT

- Does nothing to prevent tragic shootings.
- Creates red tape and bureaucratic hoops for law-abiding gun owners to jump through.
- Expands the definition of assault weapon.
- Requires the registration of certain firearms with the state police.
- Requires the recertification of pistol permits every five years.
- Criminalizes possession of magazines that can contain more than 10 rounds of ammunition, regardless of when they were manufactured. Large capacity magazines can be transferred within one year to someone out-of-state or someone who can legally possess them or be modified so they cannot be reversed through reasonable means to accept more than 10 rounds.
- Criminalizes the possession of magazines stocked with more than seven rounds. Outlaws possession of magazines stocked with more than seven rounds, even in your home (although you can possess magazines with up to 10 rounds at a recognized range or competition).
- Creates the Statewide License and Record Database, maintained by the state police at an estimated taxpayer cost of at least \$27 million. Please note: criminal conviction, mental health, and all other records contained in this database will be periodically checked to determine continued pistol permit and weapons possession eligibility.
- Requires NICS background checks for private gun sales/exchanges, except between immediate family members.
