Assemblyman Santabarbara established the **Emergency Water Infrastructure Repair Fund** in this year's state budget and **secured \$10 million** to help communities like Amsterdam make emergency repairs **when they are needed.**

The \$920,000 award to Amsterdam includes:

- ✓ **\$560,000** to complete emergency repairs to the sanitary sewer system
- ✓ **\$360,000** to repair the damaged water transmission main that serves the south side of the city
