ALBANY TAKES A STEP FORWARD ON ETHICS REFORMS

Since 2013, I have championed ethics reforms to remove the culture of corruption that plagues Albany.

This year, I worked hard to ensure first passage of *Constitutional Amendment A10739*, which strips pension and retirement benefits from any public officer who is convicted of corruption. The legislation must pass again next year so it can be brought to the voters by 2017.

Ethics reform package (A10742) was signed into law in 2016.

- ✓ Independent expenditure reforms
- ✓ Disclosure requirements for political consultants and 501(c)(4) organizations
- ✓ Lobbying disclosure and financial reporting requirements

Let's Remove Big Money from Politics

Assemblyman McLaughlin and I will continue to push for meaningful reforms that reduce the influence of money in political elections. (A10079)

- ✓ Protect our electoral process by minimizing the ability for “pay-to-play” politics
- ✓ Limit legislative leaders to 8-year term limits
- ✓ Reduce contributions to campaign committees to limit the influence of money on state elections.
