Keep your eyes on the road, not your phone



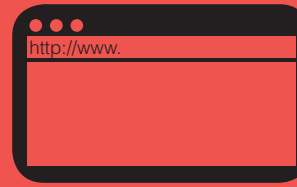
Teens who text while driving spend **10%** of the time outside their lane

40% of teens say they have been in a car when the driver used a phone



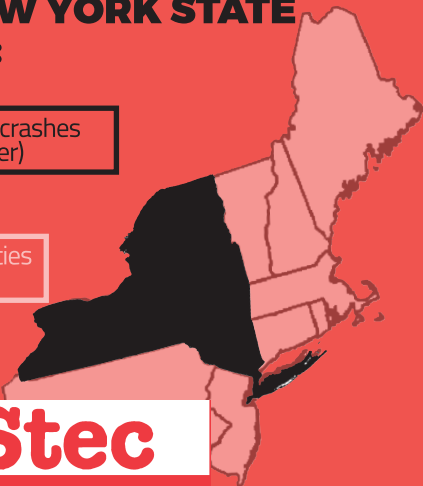
19% of drivers of all ages admit to surfing the web while driving

IN AN INSTANT, YOUR LIFE OR SOMEONE ELSE'S COULD CHANGE FOREVER. DRIVERS AT .08 BAC ARE 4X MORE LIKELY TO CAUSE A CRASH THAN SOBER DRIVERS.

IN 2014, IN NEW YORK STATE THERE WERE:

7,849 alcohol related crashes (.01 BAC or higher)

292 drunk driving fatalities (.08 BAC or higher)



Penalties for Driving While Intoxicated:



Up to \$10,000 in fines



Loss of license



Jail time

Help Keep Our Roads Safe
Have a Designated Driver or Call a Cab

"ZERO TOLERANCE" LAW

It is illegal for a driver under the age of 21 to have consumed any alcohol.

LEANDRA'S LAW

Operating a vehicle while intoxicated or under the influence of drugs with a passenger under the age of 16 is a Class E felony punishable by up to 4 years in state prison. If the passenger is killed or seriously injured, the offender could face up to 25 years in prison.

VIOLATIONS FOR TEXTING & PHONE USE WHILE DRIVING

- 5 points to driver's license
- Fine of \$50-\$200 plus surcharge
