ASSEMBLYWOMAN JANET DUPREY HAS PROPOSED REFORMS TO COMMON CORE

Simply Put, Common Core Has:

- Treated students as experiments
- Taken the creativity out of education
- Threatened non-traditional courses such as music, art, and foreign languages
- Tested without appropriate curriculum, resulting in low test scores
- Forced our special-needs students to take these standardized tests

Evaluate State Assessments and Curriculum: Stop testing and implementation until an independent teacher panel can create age/developmentally-appropriate curriculum and assessments. **The state has stopped sharing private student data with InBloom.**

More Funding: Eliminate the GEA, allowing our schools to get the resources they need while easing the strain on taxpayers. **The 2014-15 State Budget increased both State Aid and GEA funding.**

21st Century Pathways: Create alternate pathways to a high school diploma including a Career and Technical Education pathway.

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
