Helping local schools by:

-  **increasing state aid** to area schools by over \$8 million
-  **providing real mandate relief** and **rejecting unfunded mandates** that would raise property taxes
-  **securing \$435,000 in extra funding** for local schools
-  **sponsoring legislation** to lower high-speed Internet costs for school districts, libraries and BOCES centers (A.464-B)

Supporting higher education and public libraries by:

- **Jefferson County Community College will see an increase of \$403,050 in state aid this year** – increasing state aid to community colleges for the first time in five years
- increasing funding for SUNY colleges and protecting opportunity programs such as TAP and HEOP
- increasing grant funding to the Massena Public Library and the Ogdensburg Public Library by more than \$80,000
