


Make sure you get the benefits you've earned

- **Enhanced STAR helps eligible senior homeowners** save money on their property taxes. Ask your local assessor about Enhanced STAR.

TCE Program

The **Tax Counseling for the Elderly** program (TCE) offers free tax help. IRS-certified volunteers will be available to help you with questions related to your retirement and pension and can assist with any other tax issue you may have.

What to bring with you:

- Picture ID
- Social Security cards for you, your spouse and any dependents
- All W-2 and 1099 forms
- A copy of last year's tax return
- Proof of bank account routing numbers and account numbers for direct deposit, such as a blank check
- If you are married and filing a joint tax return electronically, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms
