Work-NY: Establishes tax credits and other tax relief measures for various businesses based on hiring and investments (A.5209)

Invest-NY: Expands eligibility for the investment tax credit to all businesses in the state (A.5215)

Shop-NY: Establishes various exemptions from New York's sales and compensating use tax (A.5216-A)

Small-Business Full Employment Act: Enacts various measures to provide tax and regulatory relief for small businesses to encourage growth; enhances the Personal Income Tax exemption for small businesses (A.5898A)
