


You may be eligible for the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)

The EITC provides hardworking families with support to help cover their living expenses. To qualify, you must:

- have worked full or part time at some point during the calendar year
- be a single or married person raising qualifying children at home
- have income below \$36,920 (\$42,130 married filing jointly) with one qualifying child
- have income below \$41,952 (\$47,162 married filing jointly) with two qualifying children
- have income below \$45,060 (\$50,270 married filing jointly) with three or more qualifying children
- have income below \$13,980 (\$19,190 married filing jointly) with no qualifying children



What you'll need

- ✓ Picture IDs for you and your spouse
- ✓ A Social Security card and an accurate birth date for each family member
- ✓ W-2 forms for all jobs worked in 2012
- ✓ All 1099 forms that you received
- ✓ Copy of last year's tax return, if available
- ✓ Childcare provider's name, address and tax ID number, if applicable
- ✓ For direct deposit, bring account and routing number information for checking, savings and prepaid card accounts
- ✓ If you are self-employed, bring records for income and expenses related to your business
