GARY SUPPORTED LEGISLATION TO:

End retirement benefits for politicians who steal from taxpayers

Families who are paying off mortgages, buying groceries and saving for college should not be paying for politicians to enjoy lavish retirement benefits after they're convicted of felonies. It's wrong. (A.4643-A, S.8163)

Reform Campaign Finance

Gary wants to make sure politicians can't spend campaign contributions on anything but their elections - no cars, no fancy dinners, and no vacations with lobbyists. He also supports legislation to limit campaign contributions to county committees so New York City insiders can't buy elections in upstate New York. When we get big money out of politics, our families have a louder voice. (A.4617, A.10079A)

Require Unprecedented Transparency

Gary believes his constituents deserve to know exactly what happens in Albany. He backed a measure to make all committee votes more publicly accessible. He also backed a measure to stream all committee meetings online. (Assembly Rule Motion IV, Section 2[e], 2[g])

Empower All New Yorkers

Every community in our state faces unique challenges. Every legislator has unique ideas. That's why Gary backs a bill that would allow each member of the Assembly to bring at least one bill to the floor for a public vote each year. (A.4647)
