The 2016-17 state budget includes:

- ▶ **\$12.9 million for the Jamesville-DeWitt School District** – 7.01 percent more than last year
- ▶ **Full repeal of the Gap Elimination Adjustment (GEA)** to restore funding and preserve essential programs
- ▶ **\$19 million in library construction aid** – a \$5 million increase – to preserve access to vital learning resources
