
In my first six months as your representative, I was your voice for fiscal responsibility and government accountability. Here is just a snapshot of my fight for the people of Upstate New York.

Restored Funding for Developmental Disabilities

The governor tried to cut \$90 million from critical services that help people with developmental disabilities. I circulated a petition and successfully pressured the governor into restoring these cuts to protect the most vulnerable members of our society.



Helped Our Family Farms I helped secure a two percent cap on agricultural land assessments, which will help family farms stay in business. This will also help lower the cost of your grocery bill. This is a good first step, but more needs to be done for family farms to reduce their costs and the regulations that weigh them down.



Fought for Tax Relief This year's budget did not raise income taxes, but taxes were not cut either. New York's highest-in-the-nation taxes drive families and businesses out of the state. I will continue to fight to drastically reduce income taxes, property taxes and to reduce the cost of living in New York.



Defended the Second Amendment

The governor started the year by trampling on the Second Amendment rights of all New Yorkers by passing the NY SAFE Act. In response, I organized protests and informational meetings to rally the people against the laws. The only acceptable remedy for these ill-conceived laws is full repeal, and I will continue to fight for law-abiding citizens' Second Amendment rights.



Spoke Out Against Corruption After a year in which unprecedented numbers of politicians were arrested, I fought corruption by pushing for the stripping of pensions from corrupt politicians, recall elections and a part-time legislature. I also support slashing lawmakers' pay in half to save taxpayers hundreds of thousands of dollars and am a co-sponsor of the Public Officers Accountability Act, which includes many of these proposals.
