+ REGISTER BOATS & PERSONAL WATERCRAFTS

All boats equipped with motor propulsion must be registered with the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). Be sure to keep your registration certificate on board.

+ FOLLOW THE SPEED LIMIT

While the speed limit may vary on bodies of water, such as lakes, remember that the speed limit on all public waters is 5 mph within 100 feet of the shore, docks, piers, rafts, floats and anchored boats. Not only is speeding illegal, it's dangerous and you could be held liable for damages.

+ DON'T OPERATE BOATS OR PERSONAL WATERCRAFT WHILE INTOXICATED

Boating While Intoxicated (BWI) is a serious offense, similar to a DWI. If a boater is arrested for BWI they could face fines, imprisonment, and suspension or revocation of boating privileges/registration. There is zero tolerance for underage drinking.
