Mark Johns: Real Reform, Real Results

Assemblyman Mark Johns has been working across the aisle and with both houses of the state Legislature to get Albany's attention focused on the measures we care about the most:

- ✓ **REAL TAX RELIEF:** Mark Johns voted to cap our property taxes (A8323) and deliver much-needed tax relief to middle-class families (A9009-C). Mark Johns consistently voted against tax hikes over the past 6 years to save us \$12.3 billion.
- ✓ **REAL REFORM:** Mark Johns' real reform platform would save us more than \$150 million annually and create term limits (A4651). Mark delivered on holding Albany accountable with pension forfeiture (A10739-A), campaign finance reform (A10742), and voted against legislative pay raises (A6721-A). He has never missed a floor vote, making him one of just four members with perfect attendance over 6 years.
- ✓ **REAL SUPPORT FOR OUR SCHOOLS:** Since first elected Mark Johns delivered record increases in education aid totaling \$5.6 billion more for our schools (A.9003-D) and worked to bring relief from Common Core (APPLE Plan).
- ✓ **REAL PROGRESS FOR SUSTAINABLE GROWTH:** Mark Johns knows that without a substantial investment to improve our roads, bridges and infrastructure, job creation and business growth in our community cannot succeed. He has worked to raise awareness for these needed improvements and now Albany leaders are listening – and starting to deliver necessary funds.
- ✓ **REAL CARE FOR OUR COMMUNITY:** Mark Johns cares about our community and that's why he fought to enact the Women's Equality Agenda and to get Albany to act on the heroin epidemic sweeping across our state (HELP Plan, A10725, A10726, A10727). He's delivered for us, and is still fighting to lower the cost of higher education for our kids, make life more affordable for seniors, and ensure Monroe County suburbs remain excellent neighborhoods to call home.
