Implementing a **veteran speaker education program** for veterans to share their experiences and provide information on American military history (Ch. 183 of 2013)



Recognizing the many contributions of veterans of the Cold War era by awarding each with a state **Cold War Certificate** (A.5890, passed both houses)



Establishing a process to determine the best site for a **state veterans' cemetery**, based on the needs of veterans and the location of other cemeteries (Ch. 57 of 2013)
