

Assemblyman Gantt Sponsors Electronic Voter Registration Legislation (A.10371)

In May, Assemblyman Gantt introduced legislation which would establish an electronic voter registration process. When this bill becomes law, people will be given the option to register to vote online through interactions with several state agencies. Assemblyman Gantt also supported several bills which would dramatically expand voter registration and make it easier for people to vote.


