

Assemblyman Sean Ryan helps pass legislation to stop prescription drug abuse

Assemblyman Ryan helps pass legislation – known as I-STOP – to:

- crack down on illegal trafficking of painkillers to help prevent untimely death due to prescription drug abuse
- establish a real-time, controlled-substance database
- require doctors to review a patient's controlled-substance prescription history before prescribing certain medications (A.10623)

“Prescription drug abuse is a serious problem that can lead to overdose. This new database will help keep these dangerous drugs out of the hands of abusers.” – Assemblyman Ryan
