Cleaning Up Woodlawn Beach



Assemblyman Ryan recently joined County Executive Mark Poloncarz to kick-off construction of the Rush Creek Interceptor Project which will help to clean up Woodlawn Beach in Hamburg. Funded by \$5 million from New York State, the project will divert sewer overflows, and prevent contaminated discharge into Lake Erie. This will help keep the beach free of bacteria and open more days during the summer season.
